A 1910 Greek Revival in Wilson, N.C.



The Oettinger House, or better known to locals as The Joelda Terrace, was featured in the March issue of This Old House. There is a one page article highlighting this house as an endangered property. This property has been vacant for over 20 years and is desperate for a new owner.

This Greek Revival cottage was built circa 1913 as a single family home for the Oettinger family. After living in the house for over a decade they purchased another home and they converted this one into three apartments. They named it after the children using the first two letters of their names creating the Joelda Terrace.
