Landmark Gold-Harrell House Sold

. Wilson Landmark, the Gold-Harrell House, located at 304 Vance Street has been sold. The buyer, Ed Lackie, originally from Cape Cod, Massachusetts has moved from Fountain Valley, California and plans to rehabilitate the house. Lackie is a contractor which will serve him well as he begins work on the 1884 house located in the Old Wilson Historic District.

The June 2011 issue of *This Old House Magazine* featured the house as an endangered property with a full page story. After seeing the article, Lackie visited Wilson to view the property during the summer months.

This is the second house featured in *This Old House Magazine* which has been sold by Preservation of Wilson. The March 2010 issue featured the Oettinger House, 219 Broad Street, which was sold to Kathy and Robert Ward from Indiana.
